Overview

Prior to law school, Alec worked in then-Governor Charlie Baker’s office where he helped develop low-income housing policy in the Commonwealth. While at Tufts, Alec was a member of the Varsity Squash team, played soccer and lacrosse, and wrote an undergraduate honors thesis examining the role that existential outrage takes in American voters’ propensity to vote against their economic interests.
